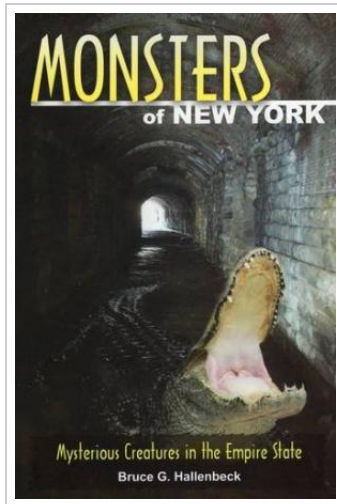




Monsters of New York: Mysterious Creatures in the Empire State (Paperback)
