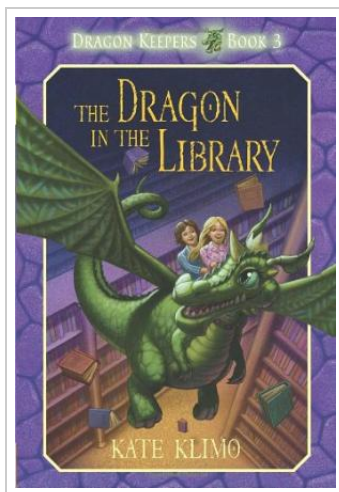




The Dragon in the Library
