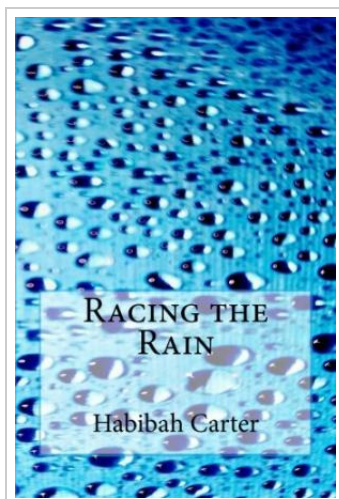




Racing the Rain (Paperback)
