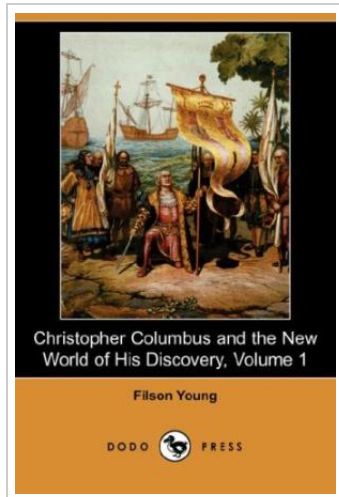




Christopher Columbus and the New World of His Discovery, Volume 1 (Dodo Press) (Paperback)
