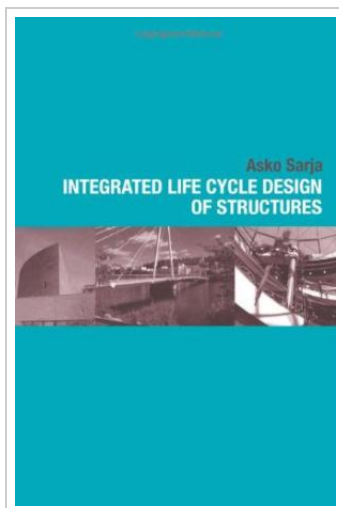




Integrated Life Cycle Design of Structures (Hardback)
