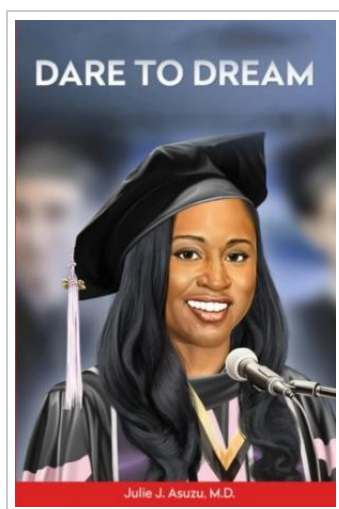



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Dare to Dream: From Hopeless to Harvard (Paperback)
