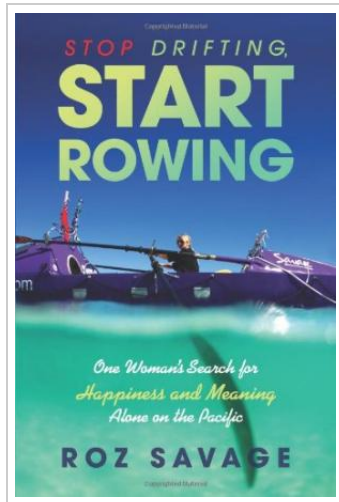




Stop Drifting, Start Rowing: One Woman's Search for Happiness and Meaning Alone on the Pacific
