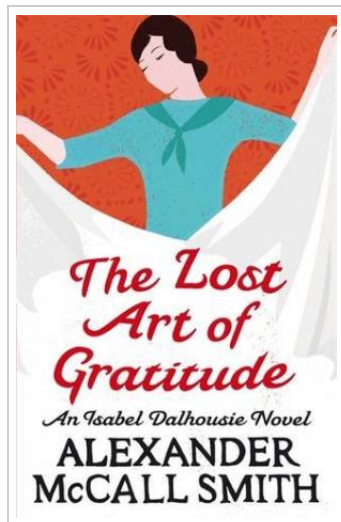




The Lost Art of Gratitude: An Isabel Dalhousie Novel
