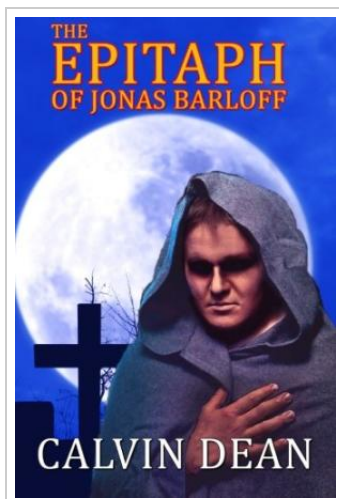




The Epitaph of Jonas Barloff (Paperback)
