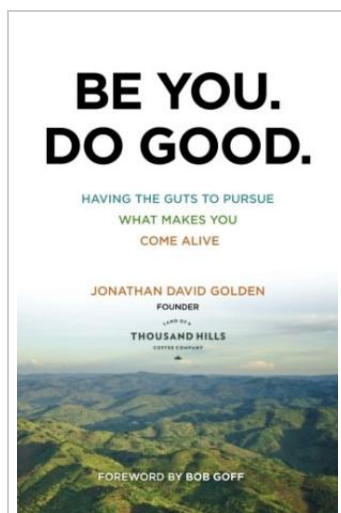




Be You. Do Good.
