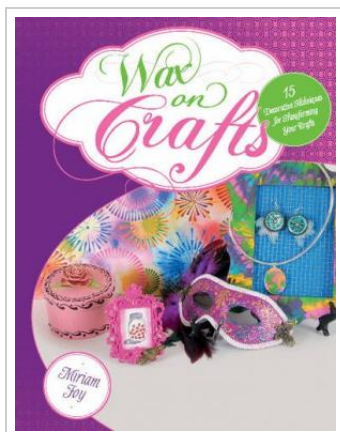




Wax on Crafts: 15 Decorative Techniques for Transforming Your Crafts
