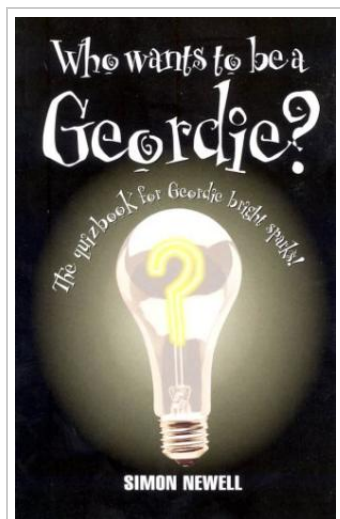




Who Wants to be a Geordie?
