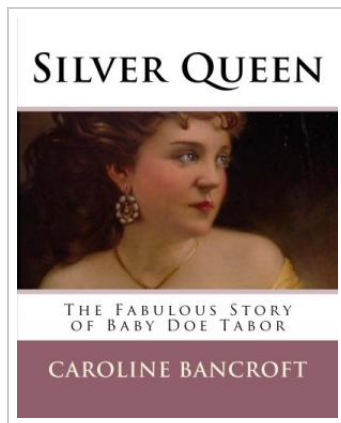




Silver Queen: The Fabulous Story of Baby Doe Tabor (Paperback)
