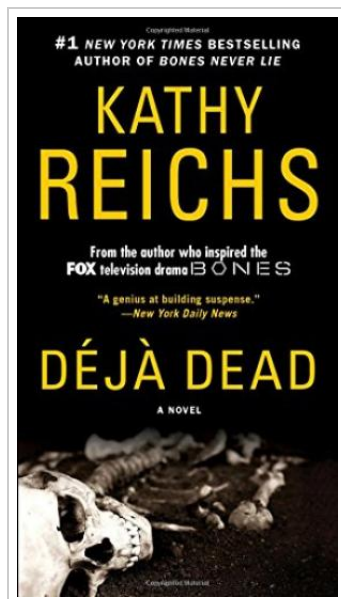




Deja Dead
