In performing this analysis, the Civil Engineering Research Foundation (CERF) contacted more than a dozen federal agencies and coordinated with the Federal Laboratory Consortium (FLC) to obtain data from 257 of the federal laboratories. The objective of the analysis was to establish baseline information regarding the federal government's role in public works infrastructure research and development (PWI R&D). What, where, and how PWI R&D is accomplished by the federal government is the focus of this analysis. After providing background information and defining "public works infrastructure," the report provides an overview of responses collected from a variety of government agencies concerning their perceived role in PWI R&D. As part of the effort to determine whether federal PWI R&D meets national public works infrastructure needs, a typical federal R&D...



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
