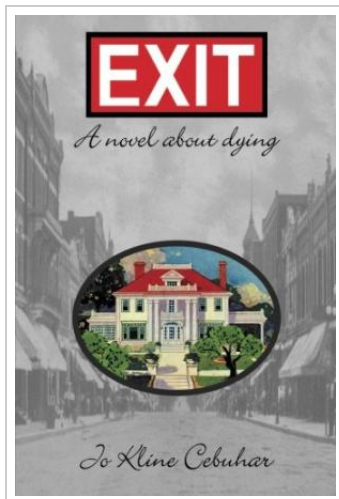




Exit - A Novel about Dying (Paperback)
