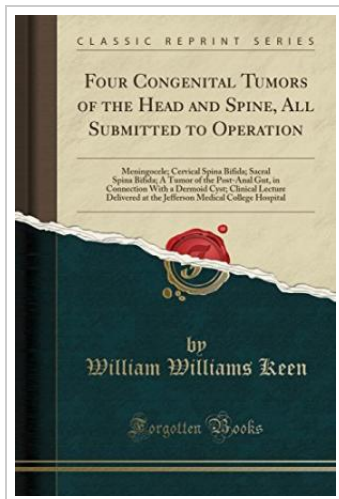

The first three are associated with imperfect development of the posterior or neural arches of the vertebrae, and the fourth is a double anomaly, illustrating a very rare form of tumor arising from an Obsolete canal, with another from developmental inversion of the skin. The first and third I shall operate on before you the second was a case in my private practice operated on in this hospital, and the fourth was Operated on at St. Agnes s Hospital.
