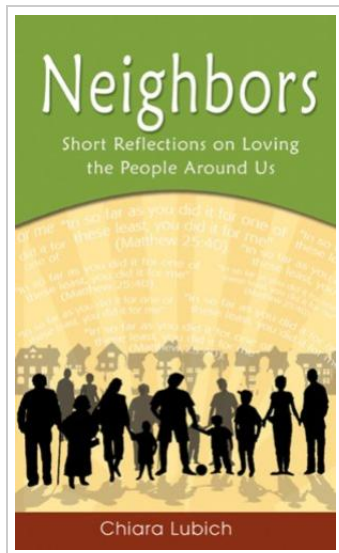




Neighbors: Short Reflections on Loving the People Around Us
