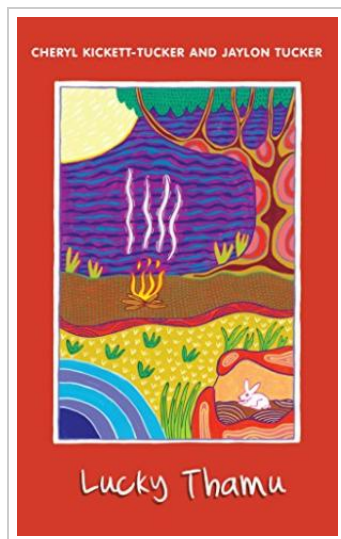




Lucky Thamu: Waarda Series (Paperback)
