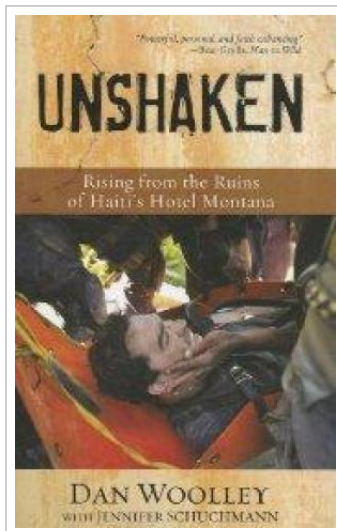




Unshaken: Rising from the Ruins of Haiti's Hotel Montana
