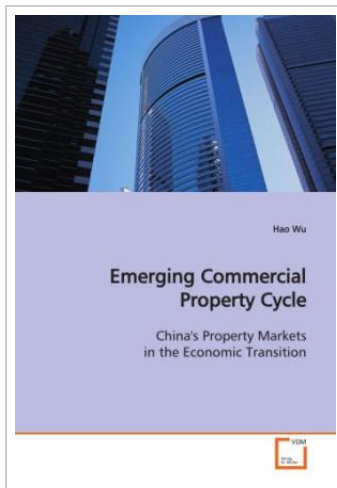




Emerging Commercial Property Cycle
