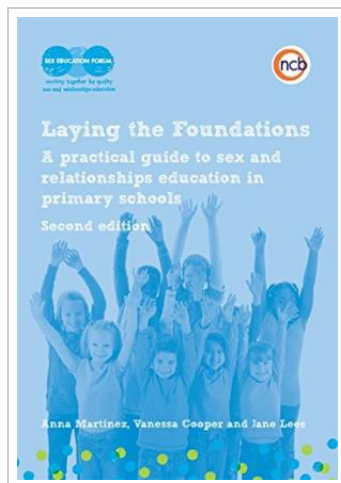




Laying the Foundations, Second Edition: A practical guide to sex and relationships education in primary schools
