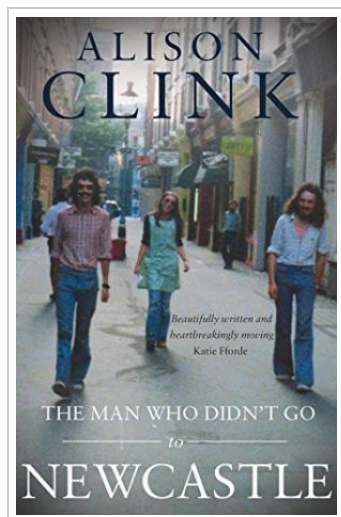




The Man Who Didn't Go to Newcastle
