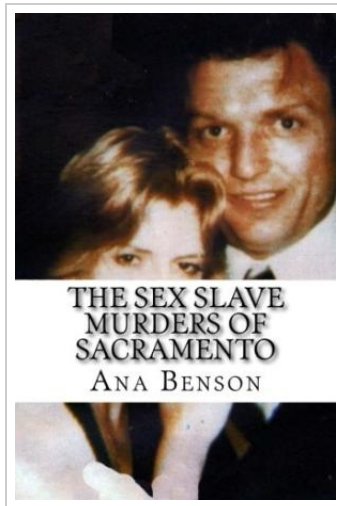




The Sex Slave Murders of Sacramento (Paperback)
