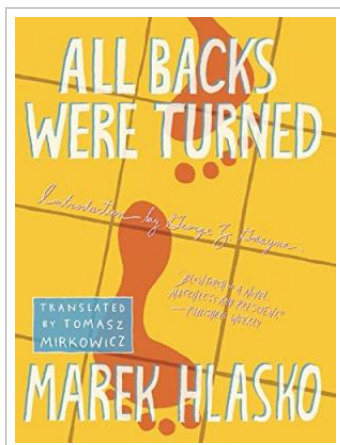




All Backs Were Turned (Paperback)
