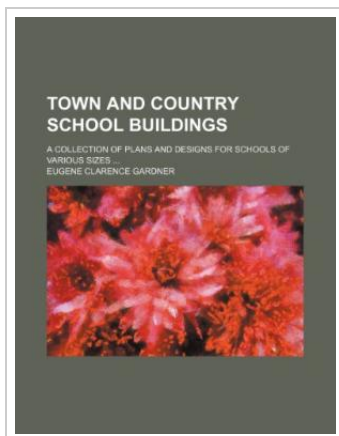




Town and Country School Buildings A Collection of Plans and Designs for Schools of Various Sizes
