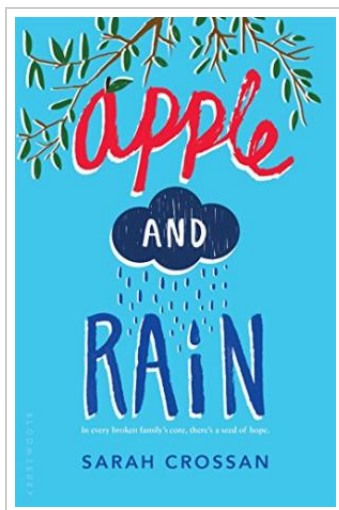




Apple and Rain (Paperback)
