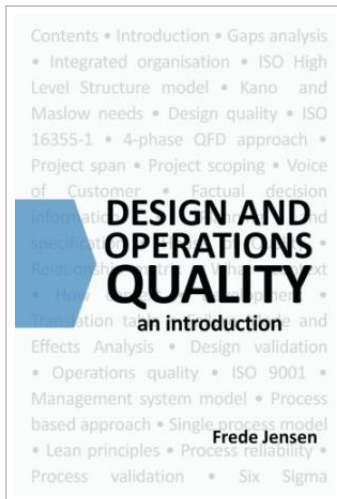




Design and Operations Quality: An Introduction (Paperback)
