A 1. 2 Organization of the Report The material in Section 1. 3 provides a concise summary of the overall Earth Avoidance study, the factors considered, the manner in which the mission is to be flown from launch through the time of the second Earth flyby, and the results. The recommended approach to reading this report, for both the reader looking for a quick overview as well as the reader planning a detailed perusal, is to read this summary before going into the more detailed technical material of Sections 2, 3, and 4 and the Appendix. Section 2 contains overview material on mission design, navigation, sequencing, and the spacecraft, with particular emphasis on how each of these areas relates to the overall issue of inadvertent entry. This material is primarily intended as background information for the reader not familiar with the Galileo Project, and generally does not describe work...



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
