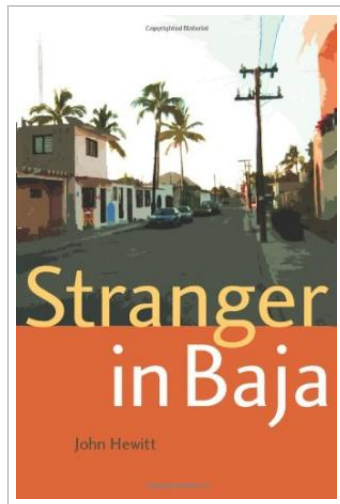




Stranger in Baja (Paperback)
