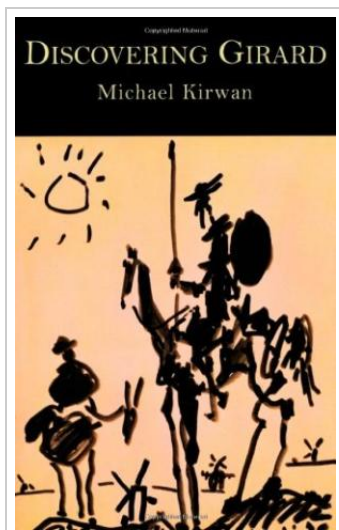




Discovering Girard (Paperback)
