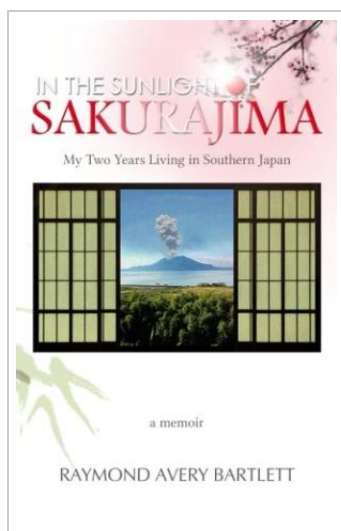




In the Sunlight of Sakurajima: My Two Years Living in Southern Japan (Paperback)
