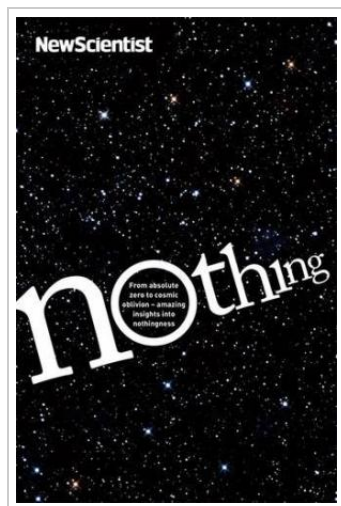




Nothing: From Absolute Zero to Cosmic Oblivion - - Amazing Insights into Nothingness
