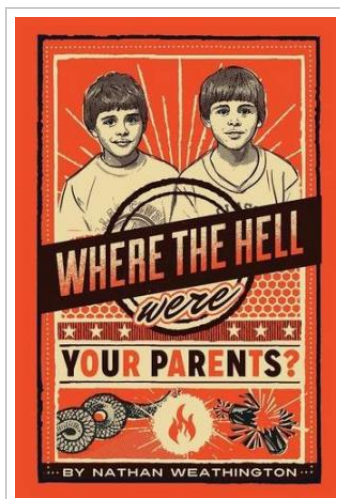




Where the Hell Were Your Parents?
