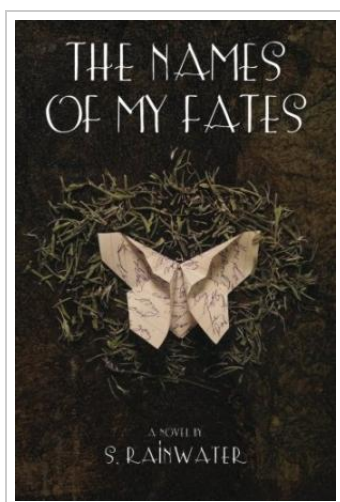




The Names Of My Fates
