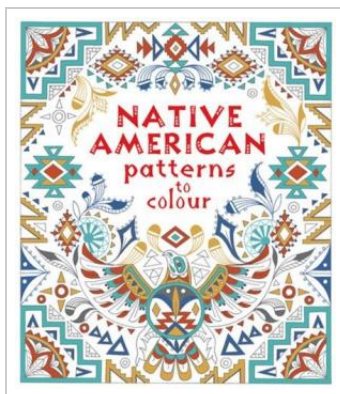




Native American Patterns To Colour (Paperback)
