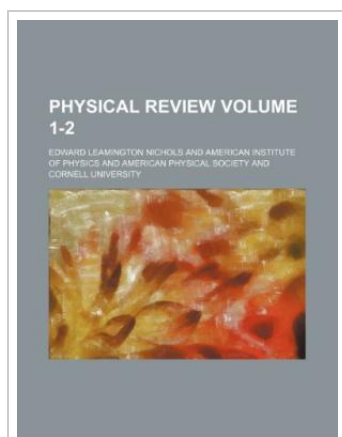

For this reason the classical little *Stereochimie* of van Hoff (new edition, 1892) is likely to be of more service in giving a clear idea of results actually reached. The latter half of Dr. Eiloart's book is an alphabetical list of literature citations, and to it is appended an illustrated description of wooden models (tetrahedral) designed to represent the structural...
