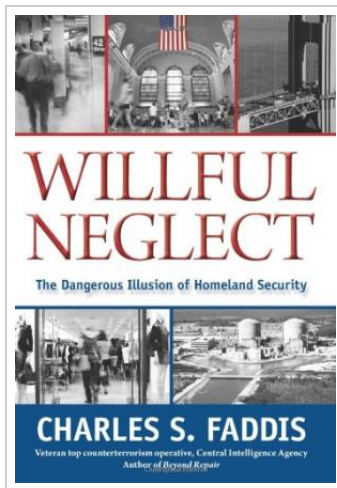




Willful Neglect: The Dangerous Illusion of Homeland Security (Hardback)
