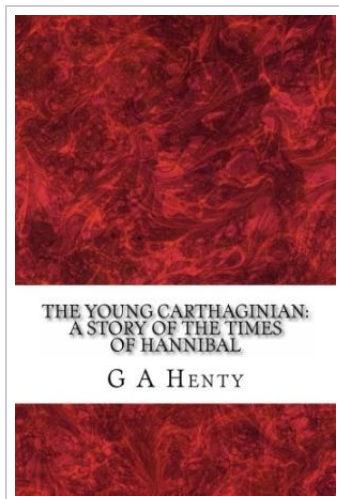




The Young Carthaginian A Story of The Times of Hannibal
