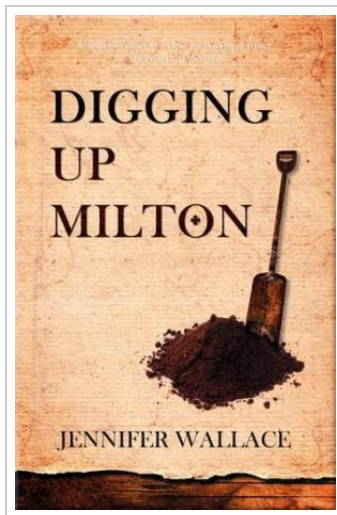




Digging Up Milton (Paperback)
