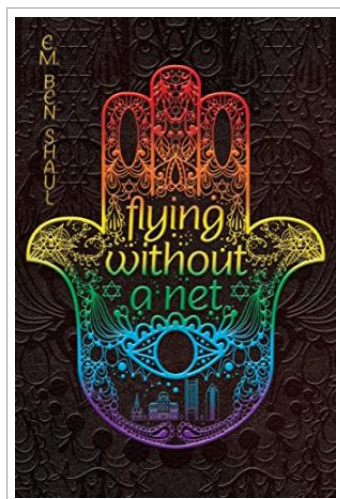




Flying Without a Net (Paperback)
