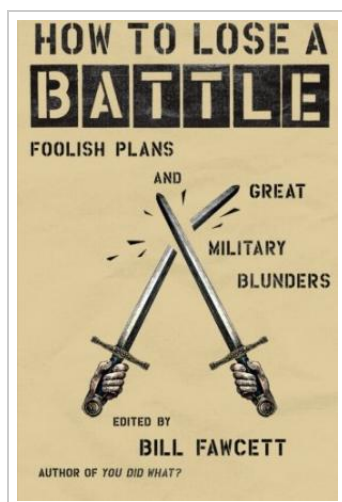




How to Lose a Battle: Foolish Plans and Great Military Blunders
