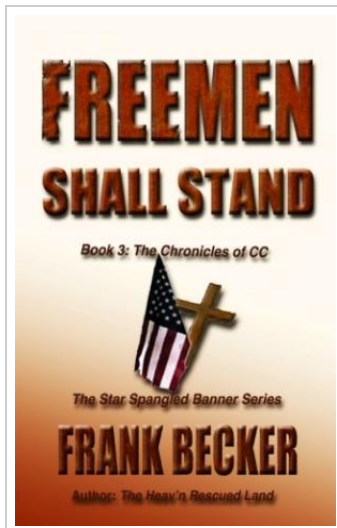




Freemen Shall Stand The Chronicles of CC Volume 3
