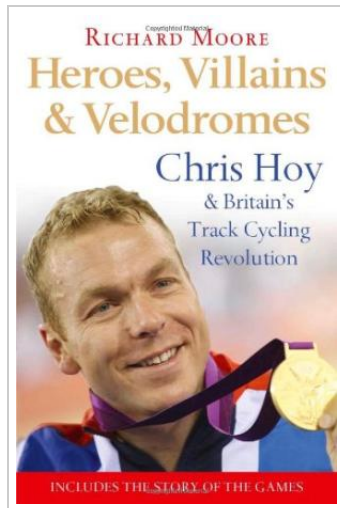




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Heroes, Villains and Velodromes: Chris Hoy and Britain's Track Cycling Revolution
