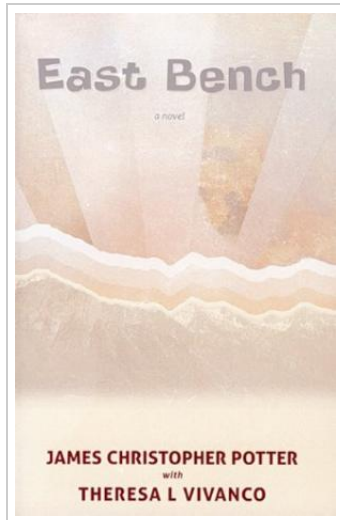




East Bench
