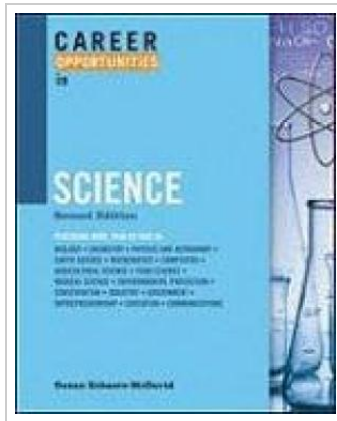




Career Opportunities in Science (Paperback)
