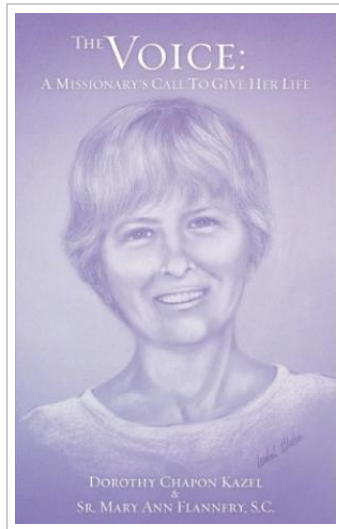




The Voice: A Missionary's Call to Give Her Life
