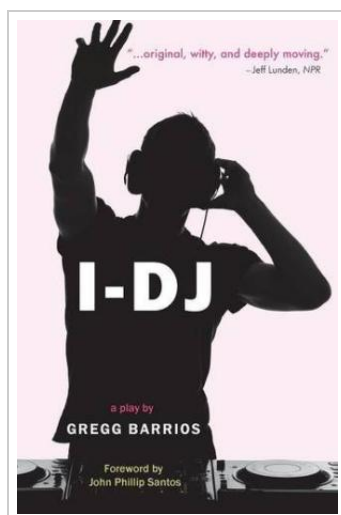




I-DJ (Paperback)
