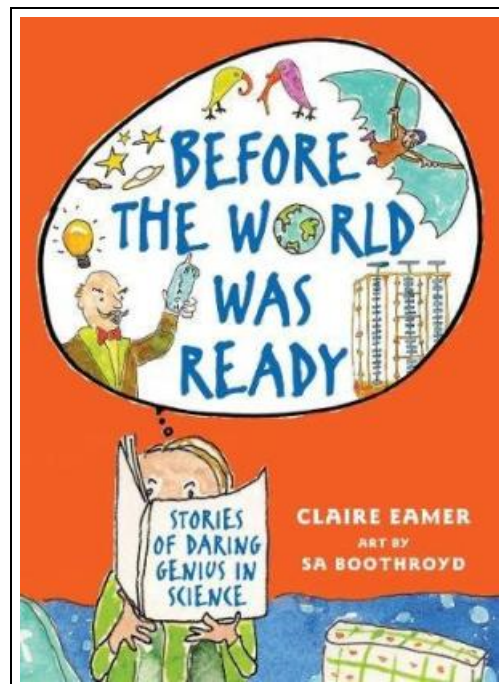


Before the World Was Ready: Stories of Daring Genius in Science (Hardback)
