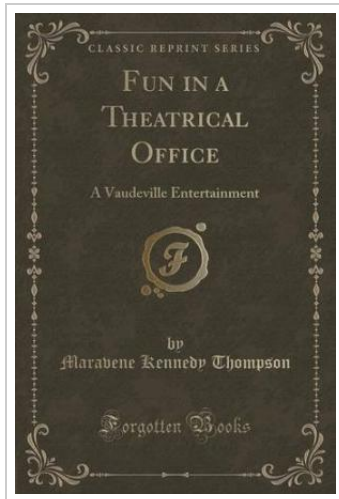




Fun in a Theatrical Office: A Vaudeville Entertainment (Classic Reprint)

It is more realistic to have piano on the stage, as part of the office furnishings. Further, the performers should address Loud, and act to him. He is seated well front, making this possible. During the times when Loud is seated, he should interestedly look at or listen to the performers....



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
